Dear Parents/Guardians,

I hope this letter finds you and your families doing well as we continue to navigate school operations during the COVID 19 Pandemic. As you are aware from Mr. Scavelli's previous communication, the Hess School will be moving to the next phase of students' return to school. Beginning on Monday, April 12th all students currently attending school on either Cohort A or B will now be attending school 4 days a week with Cohort C. At this time, Wednesday will continue to be virtual for all students

Students on virtual instruction will remain on virtual instruction.

We will continue to operate on the same time schedule. Doors open for student arrival beginning 8:30 am with buses departing 1:30 pm daily.

Students who were on the waiting list for return to hybrid instruction, as of March 24, 2021 as a result of missing the February 22nd request deadline, will also be attending in-person beginning on April 12th. **Students who were on the waitlist will be contacted directly by office staff to confirm their return to school. For those on the wait list that requested bus transportation, bus passes will be mailed to you next week with a start date of April 12th.**

For those families that requested transportation we would like to encourage you to utilize the busing service. Due to limited seating on buses, our parent drop-off and pick-up experience additional volume.

Due to the increased volume with respect to parent drop-off please be sure to note the following:

Morning Drop-Off Procedures

(Note: WE CAN NOT OPEN DOORS EARLIER THAN 8:30 am THIS SCHOOL YEAR)

If you decide to drop off your child/children please be aware of our procedures and share this information with anyone who will be dropping off your children. Drop-off will continue to take place in front of the building at the Main Entrance.

- You must enter the entrance closest to Rt. 559 (Somers Point/Mays Landing Road). If you are the first car dropping off, **you will pull up PAST the Main Entrance. Please follow directions given by our Resource Officer/duty staff.**
- Upon pulling in you should **get in the drop-off lane right next to the curb/sidewalk.**
- At 8:30, **once duty staff is present**, we will begin to unload the cars; approximately 8 at a time.
- As children are exiting your car **curbside**, your car should be in park.
- **Once you are in the drop-off lane you must wait your turn and remain in that lane until your child/children have exited your vehicle and it is safe to proceed forward. Please drive slowly when proceeding around the building.**



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Once inside there will be duty staff available to escort children to their classrooms. At this time there will be no visitors in the building. We now have a walk-up window located at the front of the building should you need to drop off or pick up items. If you are picking up your child before the end of the school day prior to 1:05 PM, you should use this window. After 1:05 pm you should use the procedure below.

Please be aware **parking in the front of the building will be closed during the morning drop-off time and will re-open at approximately 9:00 am.**

DUE TO INCREASED VOLUME, OUR PARENT PICK UP PROCEDURES WILL CHANGE - PLEASE REVIEW:

As you drive into the parent pick up area you will need to locate temporary parking.

- Once safely parked you will proceed to the tent area maintaining a distance of six feet in the line.
- A duty staff member with a walkie-talkie will approach. Please have your ID and Red Student Card Available for their viewing.
- The staff member will then call for your child(ren) to be escorted to you and record that your child(ren) were picked up.
- We ask that you exercise caution when returning to your car and exiting the parent-pick up area.

We thank you in advance for your patience in working with us and fellow parents to ensure a safe parent-pick up process for everyone.
